## HS BASKETBALL: NORTHERN CAMBRIA 58, PURCHASE LINE 30 -- Dunchack tops 1,000

PURCHASE LINE - Janae Dunchack, a senior forward, reached 1,000 points in her career with a 22-point effort in Northern Cambria's 58-30 win over Purchase Line in a Heritage Conference girls' basketball game Thursday.

"It's been such a pleasure to coach her," said Northern Cambria coach Eric Thomas. "She's so athletic and she can do so many things. She guards the best player on every team we play, guard or forward, and she's a rebounding machine. On top of that she's been a consistent presence offensively over the last four years."

Breanna Kochinsky added 16 points for the Colts. Ariel Rocco tacked on 12 points.

Patience McCullough led Purchase Line with 12 points. Cassie Brocius added 10 points.

Northern Cambria (17-4, 16-3) travels to Penns Manor on Saturday, and Purchase Line (6-12, 3-12) visits Ligonier Valley on Monday.

KENWOOD - Marion Center erased an eight-point fourth-quarter deficit and earned a come-from-behind victory over Penns Manor in a Heritage Conference game.

Trailing 42-34 after three quarters, Marion Center outscored Penns Manor 18-9 in the fourth period.

"We had a mental lapse in the fourth quarter," said Penns Manor assistant coach Kristen Holby. "We made a few mistakes and then the turnovers snowballed. ... Credit Marion Center for the comeback. They capitalized on our mistakes late in the game."

Bridget McClure led Marion Center with 12 points. Amy Fairman added 11 points.

Kayla Gillo paced Penns Manor with a game-high 14 points. Autumn Mattis chipped in 12 points.

Penns Manor (13-6, 9-6) plays host to Northern Cambria on Saturday. Marion Center (18-3, 14-3) opens the District 6 Class AA playoffs Tuesday against West Branch at Hollidaysburg High School.

HOMER-CENTER 45 BLAIRSVILLE 18

HOMER CITY - Lauren Valyo nearly outscored Blairsville by herself, pouring in 17 points to lead Homer-Center in a Heritage Conference game.

Homer-Center bounced back from a 22-point loss the previous night. The Wildcats held Blairsville to eight points or fewer in every quarter and put the game out of reach in the middle quarters, outscoring the Bobcats 27-6.

This performance was the opposite of Wednesday's game, when Homer-Center suffered an 85-63 loss to Marion Center, a game in which the Wildcats yielded 12 3-point field goals to the Stingers.

"We didn't play that bad. They just shot the lights out of the ball," Homer-Center coach Tom Lasher said of the Marion Center game. "Tonight we got back on track."

Katelyn Skinner added 11 points for the Wildcats.

Marissa Falcone had five points to lead Blairsville.

Homer-Center (13-8, 10-7) opens the District 6 Class A playoffs next week against Northern Cambria, but the date and site have not been determined. Blairsville (6-12, 6-9) welcomes Ligonier Valley this evening in a varsity-only game.
