KENWOOD - Erica Holby reached 1,000 points in her career in the first quarter, and Penns Manor held on for a 69-66 victory over Marion Center in a Heritage Conference girls' basketball game on Wednesday night.

Holby, a 5-foot-3 senior guard, scored 19 points.

"Obviously when you hit a milestone like this, you've had a successful career," said Ken Holby, Penns Manor coach and Erica's father. "She's a student of the game, and she works hard. She's very deserving of this accomplishment."

The Comets trailed 38-32 at halftime, but with help from Holby, Jess Heidenthal, Rachael Reilly and Autumn Mattis, Penns Manor finished the comeback. Heidenthal finished with 13 points, Reilly notched 14 points, and Mattis contributed 17 points.

Sarah Fyock, a senior forward, led Marion Center with 19 points.

Both teams play at home Friday. Penns Manor (4-2) plays host to Ligonier Valley, and Marion Center (2-4) welcomes Northern Cambria.
